

Author guidelines

Papers can be presented in English, Spanish, Italian or French. All the papers must include the **title both in the language of the paper and in English**. The **abstract** (max. 300 words) and the **keywords** (max. 4) **must be only in English**.

All papers must follow the **Paper Template**, available in the section “Download” of the website <https://fortmed2020.wordpress.com/> (see column on the left).

Two types of paper will be accepted:

- **Full Paper**: 5 to 8 pages, including images, endnotes and references.
- **Short paper**: 4 pages, including images, endnotes and references.

Papers will be sent by e-mail to fortmed2020@gmail.com.

A Word file (.doc or .docx) and Adobe Acrobat (.pdf) file should be included. Name the file with the surname of the first author. **The .pdf file will be sent without personal data.**

It is possible to send the attachment of up to 10 Mb in a single email. If the document takes up more space, please send it through a download link (Dropbox or similar) or using a file transfer service like WeTransfer, Jumbo or similar.

The Scientific Committee will conduct a blind peer review, determining the acceptance or rejection of papers, and in any case, the facts justifying the exclusion or the requests for modification to be sent for **final acceptance**.

All duly accepted papers will be published in the Conference proceedings with ISBN, after paying registration fee by at least one author.

Submissions received after the deadline may not be included in the Conference proceedings.

Guidelines for the drafting of the text:

Respect strictly the general template setting.

Figures:

Figures must be numbered and cited in the text (Fig. X).

Do not insert images on the first page.

Insert images .jpg (CMYK) with resolution 300 dpi.

- 1 column, 62.5 mm wide image.
- 2 columns (overall width), 13.3 mm wide image.

Figure authors must be referred in each figure.

Notes:

Include notes at the end of the text, in case it is necessary. Do not insert footnotes.

References:

Include references according to the Harvard style at the end of the text.

References in the text must follow the next format (Harvard style):

(Coscollá, 2005, p. 30)

(Coscollá, Millet y Arenal, 2005, pp.30-41)

(Coscollá et al., 1999) in case there are four or more authors.

(Coscollá, 2007, p. 189; Arenal, 1999, pp. 165-176) when different publications are cited at the same point.



Terms in any language different to the language of the text:

Generic names: italics, non-capitals.

Proper names: non-italics, capitals.

For the transliteration of Arabic terms, use the *Al-Qantara, revista de estudios árabes* (CSIC) system: ء /,/, ث /t/, ج /y/, ح /h/, ذ /d/, ش /s/, ص /s/, ض /d/, ط /t/, ظ /z/, ع /,/.
